

ANNUAL INTAKE - 40 SEATS

ELIGIBILITY

- The candidate should be citizen of India
- Candidates over 17 years of age, on or before 31st December of the year in which admission is sought.
- The candidate must have passed (HSC) 10+2 examination from a recognised board/Equivalent board.
- NEET exam appeared in which admission is sought.
- Candidate should score minimum of 50% mark in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology with English core/elective.
- Candidate should be medically fit.

SELECTION PROCEDURE

The selection of the candidate will be on the basis of Maharashtra CET cell merit list.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE AND ELIGIBILITY (BPTh)

Admission is open to both male and female candidates. criteria laid down by OTPT Council and MUHS is followed for admission.

- Duration of the course: 4 years + 6 Months internship
- Annual intake: 40 students.
- Nationality: Candidate should be citizen of India
- Age limit: The minimum age for admission shall be 17 years on 31st December of the year in which admission is sought.
- Minimum education:
 - 10+2 class passed with Science (PCB) & English Core/English Elective from recognized board under AISSCE/CBSE/ICSE/SSCE/HSCE or other equivalent Board.
- Student shall be medically fit.
- Students appearing in 10+2 examination in Science conducted by National Institute of Open School with 45% marks.
- Candidate should have passed NEET exam applicable for the current year.
- Student shall be admitted once in a year.

CODE OF CONDUCT AND DISCIPLINE

- Timings: 09:30am to 5:00pm
- A grace time of 10 minutes will be permitted to a student entering clinics late following they will be marked late. 3 late marks will be considered as one day of absenteeism.
- Payment of fees on time.
- Incomplete scholarship forms will not be accepted and college will not be responsible for late reception of scholarship.
- Students with less than 80% attendance will not be eligible to appear for university exams.
